11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1791 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person who, without good cause, maliciously and knowingly
16 cuts or damages a fence used for the production or containment of
17 cattle, bison, horses, sheep, swine, goats, domestic fowl, exotic
18 livestock, exotic poultry or any game animals or domesticated game
19 such that there is a loss or damage to the property is guilty of a
20 misdemeanor. Any person convicted of a second or subsequent offense
21 pursuant to this section, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by
22 a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by
23 imprisonment in the State Penitentiary not exceeding two (2) years,
24 or by both such fine and imprisonment.
