7 An Act relating to standards of care in extreme  
8 emergencies; authorizing the State Board of Health to  
9 adopt certain rules and requirements; providing for  
10 codification; providing an effective date; and  
11 declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-1-107 of Title 27A, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The State Board of Health is authorized to adopt such rules and  
17 requirements as it deems necessary to establish adaptive standards  
18 of care where an extreme emergency exists as defined in the Oklahoma  
19 Emergency Response Act.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
