11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-101, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 3-101. The facilities within the Department of Mental
15 Health and Substance Abuse Services, which may be maintained for
16 residents of the state, are:

- 17 1. Griffin Memorial Hospital, Norman;
- 18 2. Oklahoma Forensic Center, Vinita;
- 19 3. Children's Recovery Center of Oklahoma, Norman;
- 20 4. Tulsa Center for Behavioral Health, Tulsa;
- 21 5. Carl Albert Community Mental Health Center, McAlester;
- 22 6. Jim Taliaferro Community Mental Health Center, Lawton;
- 23 7. Central Oklahoma Community Mental Health Center, Norman;

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1 8. ~~Bill Willis Community Mental Health and Substance Abuse~~
2 ~~Services Center, Tahlequah;~~

3 9. Northwest Center for Behavioral Health, Woodward;

4 ~~10.~~ 9. Oklahoma County Crisis Intervention Center, Oklahoma

6 ~~11. Norman Alcohol and Drug Treatment Center, Norman;~~ and

7 ~~12.~~ 10. Rose Rock Recovery Center, Vinita.

8 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-323A, is
9 amended to read as follows:

10 Section 3-323A. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance
11 Abuse Services shall promulgate rules and standards for
12 certification of a facility or organization that desires to be
13 certified as a ~~"Mental Illness Service Program"~~ an "Outpatient
14 Mental Health Treatment Organization".

15 B. Applications for certification as a ~~mental illness service~~
16 ~~program~~ an outpatient mental health treatment organization shall be
17 made to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
18 on prescribed forms. The Board, or the Commissioner of Mental
19 Health and Substance Abuse Services upon delegation by the Board,
20 may certify mental illness service programs for a period of three
21 (3) years, subject to renewal as provided in the rules promulgated
22 by the Board.

23 C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
24 is authorized to establish and collect certification and renewal

1 fees for certification of ~~mental illness service programs~~ outpatient
2 mental health treatment organizations as provided in Section 3-324
3 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 D. ~~A certified mental illness service program~~ An outpatient
5 mental health treatment organization shall comply with standards
6 adopted by the Board. Such standards shall be in compliance with:

7 1. The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare
8 Organizations;

9 2. The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation
10 Facilities; or

11 3. Approved medical and professional standards as determined by
12 the Board.

13 E. The following shall be exempt from certification
14 requirements as an outpatient mental health treatment organization:

15 1. Hospitals licensed by the State Department of Health; and

16 2. Individual persons in private practice as licensed

17 physicians, licensed psychologists, licensed social workers,

18 registered nurses, licensed professional counselors, licensed

19 marriage and family therapists, licensed behavioral practitioners,

20 individual members of the clergy, and certified alcohol or drug

21 abuse counselors. The exemption provided for under this paragraph

22 shall apply only to individual professional persons in their private

23 practice and not to any treatment facility operated by the person.

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
