6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971;  
7 amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, which relates  
8 to certain conditions under which firearms may be  
9 carried; adding certain condition; defining term; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1289.6.

15 CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIREARMS MAY BE CARRIED

16 A. A person shall be permitted to carry loaded and unloaded  
17 shotguns, rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a  
18 handgun license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act,  
19 ~~Sections 1 through 25 of this act,~~ pursuant to the following  
20 conditions:

21 1. When hunting animals or fowl;

22 2. During competition in or practicing in a safety or hunter  
23 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized  
24 sporting events;

1           3. During participation in or in preparation for a military  
2 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma  
3 Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve and active  
4 military forces;

5           4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized  
6 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as  
7 functioning police officials;

8           5. During a practice for or a performance for entertainment  
9 purposes; ~~or~~

10          6. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma  
11 Firearms Act of 1971, ~~Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title~~  
12 or any legislative enactment regarding the use, ownership and  
13 control of firearms; or

14          7. When living in a motor home or recreational vehicle which  
15 has been modified as a semipermanent or permanent residence and not  
16 in transport.

17          B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,  
18 rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a handgun  
19 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to  
20 the following conditions:

21           1. When going to or from the person's private residence or  
22 vehicle or a vehicle in which the person is riding as a passenger to  
23 a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs or  
24 reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or gunsmith,

1 or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or target  
2 shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized firearms  
3 activity or event and while in such places; or

4 2. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma  
5 Firearms Act of 1971, ~~Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title.~~

6 C. For purposes of subsection A of this section, "motor home or  
7 recreational vehicle" means a vehicle that is manufactured,  
8 constructed or equipped permanently as a self-propelled home or  
9 living quarters, kitchen and sleeping quarters, capable of being  
10 operated on the highways, but shall not include vehicles equipped  
11 with a camper.

12 ~~C.~~ D. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to  
13 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions,  
14 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns  
15 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the  
16 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
