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7 An Act relating to the Joint Task Force on the Grand  
8 River Dam Authority; amending Section 3, Chapter 192,  
9 O.S.L. 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3),  
10 which relates to the task force; modifying membership  
11 of the task force; requiring certain biennial  
12 meetings; authorizing additional meetings; requiring  
13 certain annual report to the task force; terminating  
14 membership of certain task force members; requiring  
15 appointment of new members by certain date; providing  
16 for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 192, O.S.L.  
2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3), is amended to read as  
follows:

Section 863.3 A. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative  
Task Force on the Grand River Dam Authority for the purpose of  
studying the functions, activities, policies, procedures and  
expenditures performed by the district and any related issues the  
task force deems appropriate. Members of the task force shall be  
appointed in January of each year following a state general election  
by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the

1 House of Representatives. Membership shall be made up of ~~all Senate~~  
2 ~~and House members whose legislative districts include a portion of~~  
3 ~~the Grand River Dam Authority district~~ five members of the Senate  
4 and five members of the House of Representatives whose legislative  
5 districts include a portion of the Grand River Dam Authority  
6 district to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate  
7 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, respectively. The  
8 President Pro Tempore and Speaker shall each designate one of their  
9 members to be cochairs of the task force. The task force shall be  
10 required to meet at least once biennially during the first session  
11 of each new legislature. Additional meetings may be called as the  
12 cochairs determine necessary. Meetings of the task force shall be  
13 called by the cochairs. A majority of the appointed members shall  
14 constitute a quorum for any meeting of the task force. Staffing  
15 assistance shall be provided by the staff of the Senate and House of  
16 Representatives.

17 B. The members of the task force created herein shall continue  
18 to serve until new members are appointed pursuant to the provisions  
19 of subsection A of this section. ~~Such~~ The task force is authorized  
20 to adopt any recommendations or issue any report it deems necessary.  
21 Any recommendations or reports shall be approved by a majority of  
22 the appointed members. Copies of any recommendations or reports  
23 issued by the task force shall be distributed to the Governor, the  
24 President Pro Tempore of the Senate ~~and,~~ the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives, the members of the Grand River Dam Authority Board  
2 of Directors and the General Manager of the Grand River Dam  
3 Authority.

4 C. The Grand River Dam Authority shall annually provide a copy  
5 of the district's most recent annual report to the members of the  
6 task force in addition to any information requested pursuant to the  
7 provisions of this section.

8 D. Members serving on ~~this~~ the task force shall be entitled to  
9 travel reimbursement as provided by Section 456 of Title 74 of the  
10 Oklahoma Statutes.

11 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
12 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

13 Members serving on the Grand River Dam Authority Task Force  
14 appointed prior to the effective date of this act are hereby  
15 terminated. Appointments of new members made pursuant to Section  
16 863.3 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be made within  
17 thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act. Future  
18 appointments of task force members shall be made in January of each  
19 year following a state general election.

20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
