10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 215.1, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 215.1. There is hereby created the office of district
14 attorney in the State of Oklahoma, which office shall be filled ~~and~~
15 in the same manner as now prevails for district judge. Filing for
16 ~~said~~ the office shall be accomplished by filing with the State
17 Election Board. There shall be one district attorney for each of
18 the district court judicial districts as they are composed and exist
19 on March 1, 1965, with the following exceptions. Provided, however,
20 that that part of Judicial District No. (14) which is Pawnee County
21 shall be consolidated with Osage County to form District Attorney's
22 District No. (10) and Judicial District No. (25) shall be
23 consolidated with Judicial District No. (19) for the purposes of
24 this act; and, provided further, that District Court Judicial

1 District No. (5) be divided into two district attorney districts,
2 one composed of Caddo, Grady, Stephens and Jefferson Counties to be
3 denominated District Attorney's District No. (6) and the other
4 composed of Comanche and Cotton Counties, to be denominated District
5 Attorney's District No. (5); and, that District Court Judicial
6 District No. (4) shall be composed of Canadian, Kingfisher, Blaine,
7 Garfield and Grant Counties to be denominated District Attorney's
8 District No. (4) and the other composed of Alfalfa, Major, Dewey,
9 Woodward and Woods Counties, to be denominated District Attorney's
10 District No. (26); that District Court Judicial District No. (15) be
11 divided into two district attorneys' districts, one composed of
12 Muskogee County to be denominated District Attorney's District No.
13 (15) and the other composed of Wagoner, Cherokee, Sequoyah and Adair
14 Counties to be denominated District Attorney's District No. (27);
15 that Creek and Okfuskee Counties shall be denominated as District
16 Attorney's District No. (24); Okmulgee and McIntosh Counties shall
17 be denominated as District Attorney's District No. (25); and
18 Pittsburg and Haskell Counties shall be denominated as District
19 Attorney's District No. (18); and Latimer and LeFlore Counties shall
20 be denominated as District Attorney's District No. (16); and
21 District Attorney's District No. (7) shall consist of Oklahoma
22 County; and, effective January 6, 2003, Kiowa, Jackson, Tillman,
23 Harmon and Greer Counties shall be denominated as District
24 Attorney's District No. (3); and, effective January 6, 2003,

1 Washita, Ellis, Roger Mills, Custer and Beckham Counties shall be
2 denominated as District Attorney's District No. (2). The State
3 Election Board shall conduct the elections in 2002 for District No.
4 (2) and District No. (3) in accordance with the provisions of this
5 section.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
