10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 85.3A, as
12 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 66, O.S.L. 2010 (74 O.S. Supp.
13 2010, Section 85.3A), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 85.3A. Compliance with the provisions of The Oklahoma
15 Central Purchasing Act shall not be required of:

- 16 1. County government;
- 17 2. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the
18 institutions, centers, or other constituent agencies of The Oklahoma
19 State System of Higher Education;
- 20 3. The telecommunications network known as OneNet;
- 21 4. The Department of Public Safety gun range;
- 22 5. The State Treasurer for the following purchases:
 - 23 a. services, including, but not limited to, legal
24 services to assist in the administration of the

1 Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, as provided in Section
2 668 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and

3 b. software, hardware and associated services to assist
4 in the administration of funds and securities held by
5 the state, as provided in Section 71.2 of Title 62 of
6 the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 6. CompSource Oklahoma if CompSource Oklahoma is operating
8 pursuant to a pilot program authorized by Sections 3316 and 3317 of
9 this title; ~~or~~

10 7. The Oklahoma Wheat Commission;

11 8. Entities contracting with the state to provide senior
12 nutrition services under the Older Americans Act; or

13 9. The Oklahoma Abstractors Board.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
