10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 103.2 of Title 20, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Any appeal of a motion for recusal of a judge shall be to the
15 Oklahoma Supreme Court, and the Court shall rule on such appeal
16 within ten (10) days. If the Court fails to rule on the appeal
17 within the ten-day period, the judge may continue to rule on the
18 action until the Court makes its determination. If the judge is
19 subsequently removed from the action, any decisions or orders made
20 prior to removal remain valid unless reversed by the succeeding
21 judge. The Administrative Director of the Courts shall promulgate
22 rules to implement the provisions of this section.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
