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7 An Act relating to motor vehicle registration
8 information; stating purpose; authorizing the
9 Commissioner of Public Safety to direct development
10 of certain cooperative agreement; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-108.3 of Title 47, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. In an effort to improve the public safety of all citizens of
17 this state, a more uniform and expeditious method of obtaining
18 ownership and registration information of all motor vehicles
19 operating on the roads and highways of this state is required. Any
20 method developed shall be conducted in accordance with subsection B
21 of this section.

22 B. In addition to the powers and duties prescribed by law, the
23 Commissioner of Public Safety shall be authorized to direct the
24 Department of Public Safety to develop a proposal for an
intergovernmental cooperative agreement pursuant to paragraph 1 of

1 subsection D of Section 1221 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes
2 between the Department and all tribal governments that issue tribal
3 license plates and maintain ownership and registration information.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
