15 A Concurrent Resolution praising the cooperative
16 efforts of local and federal law enforcement agencies
17 and city leaders in the response to the shooting
18 rampage that occurred on Friday, April 6, in north
19 Tulsa; expressing condolences to the families of
20 those killed and hopes for a swift recovery for
21 survivors; and directing distribution.

22 WHEREAS, in the early hours of Friday, April 6, 2012, three
23 people were killed and two others injured after a series of
24 shootings in north Tulsa, leaving citizens throughout Tulsa, the
state of Oklahoma, and the nation shocked and horrified; and

1 WHEREAS, law enforcement from the Tulsa Police Department, the
2 Tulsa County Sheriff's Office, the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, the
3 Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,
4 Firearms and Explosives, and U.S. Marshals demonstrated
5 professionalism and cooperation throughout the crime investigation;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, members of the law enforcement community and Tulsa city
8 leaders, including Police Chief Chuck Jordan, Mayor Dewey Bartlett,
9 and City Councilman Jack Henderson assisted in keeping the community
10 informed of law enforcement efforts and reassured citizens those
11 responsible would be found and arrested; and

12 WHEREAS, within 24 hours of the formation of the task force
13 "Operation Random Shooter" citizens provided Crime Stoppers with
14 tips leading to Sunday's arrest of two suspects.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
16 OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
17 CONCURRING THEREIN:

18 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature praises the high professionalism
19 and cooperative efforts displayed by local, state and federal law
20 enforcement and Tulsa leaders in the wake of the horrific shootings,
21 as well as the efforts of Tulsa citizens and Crime Stoppers leading
22 to the arrest of suspects in the crime.
