An Act relating to crimes and punishments;
authorizing United States Attorneys and Assistant
United States Attorneys to carry firearms under
certain circumstances; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Authorizing United States Attorneys and Assistant
United States Attorneys to carry firearms

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.28 of Title 21, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any United States Attorney or Assistant United States Attorney
may carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the State of
Oklahoma if the person has successfully completed an approved course
of firearm training conducted by a certified firearms instructor
which is equal to the minimum requirements for firearms training as
set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
