An Act relating to sunset; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4102, which relates to the State Capitol Preservation Commission; re-creating the Commission; and modifying the termination date.

SUBJECT: State Capitol Preservation Commission

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4102, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4102. There is hereby re-created, to continue until July 1, ~~2012~~ 2015, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law, the State Capitol Preservation Commission which shall be responsible for planning and supervising the preservation and restoration of the interior and exterior of the State Capitol Building, hereinafter referred to as the Capitol, and the Governor's Mansion. The Commission shall control the display of art objects in public areas of the Capitol and the Governor's Mansion.
