WHEREAS, the late S.M. "Monsieur" Moore, from his birth in 1903  
until his death at the age of 91, was the personification of the  
western pioneer; and

WHEREAS, for over 40 years, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore bred cattle  
and horses on his 10,000-acre ranch near Dewey; and

WHEREAS, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore was a founding member of several  
organizations and served as a director of the American Quarter Horse  
Association from 1964 to 1979, as well as serving as their eleventh  
president in 1961; and

WHEREAS, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore's influence was important in the successful establishment of the Dewey Bank and many civic organizations in Northeastern Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore was an unparalleled blend of horse breeder, cattleman, western pioneer, banker, oil producer, civic leader and mentor to his family and friends.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby honors the memory of S.M. "Monsieur" Moore.
