A Joint Resolution disapproving permanent rule of the State Board of Health; and directing distribution.

SUBJECT: State Board of Health rule

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any rule or portion thereof at any time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 1-1960 through 1-1980 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the State Board of Health shall promulgate the rules necessary to implement the provisions of the Home Care Act; and

WHEREAS, the promulgation of permanent rule OAC 310:662-3-4(e)(7), does not reflect the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby disapproves permanent rule OAC 310:662-3-4(e)(7).

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the State Board of Health, and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
