An Act relating to standards of care in extreme emergencies; authorizing the State Board of Health to adopt certain rules and requirements; and providing for codification.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Emergency Response Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-1-107 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Board of Health is authorized to adopt such rules and requirements as it deems necessary to establish adaptive standards of care where an extreme emergency exists as defined in the Oklahoma Emergency Response Act.
