An Act relating to bridge designations; designating  
the President George W. Bush Bridge; and providing  
for codification.

SUBJECT: Bridge designation

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.93 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The southbound bridge on US 277/US 281 crossing the Red River  
shall be designated as the "President George W. Bush Bridge". The  
Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
to be placed upon the highways bearing that name.
