An Act relating to agriculture; stating legislative intent that an airport in Oklahoma apply and receive approval from the United States Department of Agriculture and the United States Customs and Border Patrol to provide international and domestic livestock import and export functions; directing cooperation among certain entities; providing for report; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Livestock import and export functions of airport

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19-2 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that an airport in the State of Oklahoma apply and receive approval from the United States Department of Agriculture and the United States Customs and Border Patrol to provide international and domestic livestock and livestock products import and export functions. The cities of Oklahoma City and Tulsa and their respective airports, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, the United States Department of Agriculture and the United States Customs and Border

Patrol shall cooperate to achieve this intent. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall provide a progress report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Governor no later than December 1, 2012.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
