1 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 213.2, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 213.2 A. There is hereby created in the Office of the
4 State Auditor and Inspector a Performance Audit Division, subject to
5 the discretion of the State Auditor and Inspector. An Assistant
6 State Auditor and Inspector may be appointed to direct the
7 operations of the Division, subject to the supervision and control
8 of the State Auditor and Inspector at all times.

9 B. The State Auditor and Inspector, deputies and agents of the
10 Performance Audit Division may examine all books and accounts of all
11 public officers, institutions and other governmental entities
12 specified in Sections 212 through 227.9 of this title to instruct
13 the proper officers thereof in the performance of their duties and
14 to prescribe cost-effective methods of operating such governmental
15 entities; provided, however, the State Auditor and Inspector shall
16 perform the examinations authorized in this subsection upon
17 receiving a written request to do so by the Governor, the chief
18 executive officer of a governmental entity or pursuant to a joint or
19 concurrent resolution of the Legislature or at the discretion of the
20 State Auditor and Inspector. A An electronic copy of the
21 examination shall be given to the examined entity. A copy of any
22 examination conducted pursuant to this subsection shall be submitted
23 to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
24 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the appropriations and budget

1 chairs of the House of Representatives and the Senate, and the
2 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives and of the Senate.

3 C. The cost of the examinations authorized pursuant to
4 subsection B of this section shall be borne by the examined agency
5 in an amount not to exceed the actual costs of the examination or
6 from funds made available to conduct such examinations. Prior to
7 the start of such an examination, the State Auditor and Inspector
8 shall prepare in writing and present to the affected state agency an
9 estimate of the cost of the examination. If the estimate requires
10 revision, the State Auditor and Inspector shall notify the agency in
11 a prompt manner. Except as otherwise provided, the State Auditor
12 and Inspector shall recover its costs for the examination pursuant
13 to monthly progress billings presented by the State Auditor and
14 Inspector to the Office of State Finance detailing current monthly
15 costs for each examination. In addition, the State Auditor and
16 Inspector shall provide a copy of the billing to the affected state
17 agency. The Office of State Finance may deduct the amounts billed
18 from the next subsequent allotment for the corresponding state
19 agency and transfer the funds to the State Auditor and Inspector
20 Revolving Fund.

21 D. The salaries and traveling expenses of the Assistant State
22 Auditor and Inspector, deputies and agents of the Performance Audit
23 Division and the costs of material, supplies and equipment for the
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1 Division shall be paid from funds made available through
2 appropriation by the Legislature.

3 E. The State Auditor and Inspector shall submit an annual
4 report of the Performance Audit Division to the Governor, the
5 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
6 Representatives, appropriations and budget chairs of the House of
7 Representatives and the Senate, and the Minority Leader of the
8 Senate and of the House of Representatives."
