14 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5040, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 5040. A. A community action agency shall serve as a  
18 primary advocate for the reduction of the causes, conditions and  
19 effects of poverty and shall provide social and economic  
20 opportunities that foster self-sufficiency for low-income persons.  
21 Any service provided by a community action agency through the  
22 Community Services Block Grant opportunity shall be made available  
23 to all eligible persons within the community action agency's service  
24 area. The activities of a community action agency shall, subject to

1 rules and regulations promulgated by the Oklahoma Department of  
2 Commerce, include but not be limited to the following:

3 1. Informing state and local governments, private agencies and  
4 organizations, and citizens of the nature and extent of poverty  
5 within the service area;

6 2. Developing, administering, and operating community social  
7 and economic programs to reduce poverty within the entire area;

8 3. Providing and advocating for training and technical  
9 assistance to the poor and other residents within the service area  
10 to better define human problems, improve services, and facilitate  
11 citizen participation;

12 4. Promoting interagency cooperation and coordination in  
13 providing services to low-income persons;

14 5. Entering into contracts with federal, state, and local  
15 public and private agencies and organizations as necessary to carry  
16 out the purposes of this act; and

17 6. Engaging in any other activity necessary to fulfill the  
18 intent of this section and Sections ~~40~~ 5034 through ~~45~~ 5039 of this  
19 act title.

20 B. The Department of Commerce shall not execute a contract with  
21 a community action agency until the applicant submits, and the  
22 Department approves, a budget work program for expenditure of funds.  
23 Each contract shall require audits of expenditures, as provided in  
24 rules promulgated by the Department.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 7005, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 7005. A. The Oversight Committee for State Employee  
4 Charitable Contributions shall be composed of the Administrator of  
5 the Office of Personnel Management, or designee and six ~~(6)~~ state  
6 employees, of which two shall be appointed by the Governor, two  
7 shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and  
8 two shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
9 Representatives. Members shall serve at the pleasure of their  
10 appointing authorities. The provisions of Section 6 of Title 51 of  
11 the Oklahoma Statutes shall not apply to appointments to the  
12 Committee. The Committee is created to continue until July 1, ~~2012~~  
13 2016, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law.

14 B. The Committee annually shall elect a chairman from its  
15 membership. The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management  
16 shall serve as chairman until the first such election.

17 C. The Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable  
18 Contributions shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

19 1. Arrange for publication of information about the application  
20 process;

21 2. Review applications of federations electing to participate  
22 in the State Charitable Campaign and certify that a federation and  
23 each of its member agencies meet the eligibility criteria set forth  
24 in Sections 7009 and 7010 of this title;

1           3. Notify in writing each of the applying federations of its  
2 acceptance or rejection. Provided, if a federation is rejected, the  
3 Committee shall provide the reason for rejection of each of the  
4 member agencies of the federation;

5           4. Hear appeals of rejected agencies;

6           5. Delegate to the principal combined fund-raising organization  
7 the primary responsibility for the staffing ~~of~~ and the financial  
8 obligations necessary to comply with the provisions of this  
9 subsection;

10          6. Develop a pledge card to be used throughout the State  
11 Charitable Campaign;

12          7. Select a principal combined fund-raising organization to  
13 assist the Committee in gathering and accumulating the applications;  
14 and

15          8. Promulgate rules to implement the provisions of the Oklahoma  
16 State Employee Charitable Contribution Act.

17          D. The Office of Personnel Management shall provide such staff  
18 support as is required by the Committee.

19          E. The Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable  
20 Contributions is authorized to appoint such advisory councils and  
21 task forces as it deems necessary for counsel, advice and review  
22 concerning the formulation and administration of the rules,  
23 application review process and the implementation of the Oklahoma  
24 State Employee Charitable Contribution Act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
