14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1791 of Title 21, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Any person who, without good cause, maliciously and knowingly  
19 cuts or damages a fence used for the production or containment of  
20 cattle, bison, horses, sheep, swine, goats, domestic fowl, exotic  
21 livestock, exotic poultry, exotic livestock or any game animals or  
22 domesticated game such that there is a loss or damage to the  
23 property is guilty of a misdemeanor. Any person convicted of a  
24 second or subsequent offense pursuant to this section, shall be

1 guilty of a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding One Thousand  
2 Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary  
3 not exceeding two (2) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
