

1 pursuant to this act shall serve a term of three (3) years that
2 shall expire on June 30, 2006. Members appointed to the Commission
3 shall serve for terms of three (3) years. Terms of office shall
4 expire on June 30. All vacancies and unexpired terms shall be
5 filled in the same manner as the original appointment and within
6 sixty (60) days from the date of the vacancy. Members may be
7 removed by the Governor for incompetence, willful neglect of duty,
8 corruption in office, or malfeasance in office.

9 B. Members appointed to the Commission shall reside in this
10 state and shall have the following qualifications:

11 1. Two members shall have experience as a professional boxer or
12 in professional boxing promotions;

13 2. One member shall have experience as a professional wrestler
14 or in professional wrestling promotions;

15 3. One member shall have experience in sports medicine;

16 4. One member shall have experience in the cable television
17 business; and

18 5. Four members shall represent the public at large as lay
19 members.

20 C. No member of the Commission or any person related to a
21 member within the third degree by consanguinity or affinity shall
22 promote, sponsor, or have any financial interest in the promotion or
23

1 sponsorship of any professional boxing contest or professional
2 exhibition while a member of the Commission.

3 D. The members of the Commission shall elect from their
4 membership a chair and vice-chair to serve for one (1) year terms.
5 A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the purpose
6 of conducting the business of the Commission. The Commission shall
7 meet at least quarterly, and special meetings may be called by the
8 chair.

9 E. The Commission shall comply with the provisions of the
10 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, the Oklahoma Open Records Act, and the
11 Administrative Procedures Act.

12 F. All members of the Commission and such employees as
13 determined by the Commission shall be bonded as required by Sections
14 85.26 through 85.31 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

15 G. Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation
16 but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of
17 their duties as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
