11 An Act relating to elections; prohibiting certain
12 officials from receiving certain compensation;
13 providing for codification; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-102.1 of Title 26, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Any elected official that files a declaration of candidacy
20 pursuant to Section 5-102 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall
21 not receive compensation for the current elected position after a
22 period of ten (10) days of the date the declaration of candidacy was
23 filed.
