11           An Act relating to crimes and punishments;  
12           authorizing United States Attorneys and Assistant  
13           United States Attorneys to carry firearm under  
          certain circumstances; providing for codification;  
          and providing an effective date.

16   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
18   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.28 of Title 21, unless  
19   there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20           Any United States Attorney or Assistant United States Attorney  
21   may carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the State of  
22   Oklahoma if the person has successfully completed an approved course  
23   of firearm training conducted by a certified firearms instructor

1 which is equal to the minimum requirements for firearms training as  
2 set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
