

1 A. The Department of Central Services is hereby directed to
2 design and provide for the display of a plaque or other marker
3 inscribed with the names of Oklahoma residents who have been awarded
4 the Congressional Medal of Honor. The plaque or other marker shall
5 be displayed in an appropriate and dignified manner inside the State
6 Capitol building in the fourth floor rotunda area. The plaque or
7 other marker shall be placed in the State Capitol building by the
8 Department no later than January 1, 2012. As is appropriate, the
9 Department shall update the plaque or other marker to add the name
10 or names of any other Oklahoma residents who are awarded the
11 Congressional Medal of Honor.

12 B. The Department shall consult and work with the Military
13 Department to design the plaque or other marker and to compile a
14 list of all Oklahoma residents who have been awarded the
15 Congressional Medal of Honor.

16 C. Implementation of the provisions of this section shall be
17 contingent upon the Department securing private donations,
18 contributions, gifts, grants or any other monies for the purposes of
19 designing and displaying a plaque or marker as provided for in this
20 section.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
