

1 the amount it expends for total expenditures, less expenditures for
2 legal services, shall have the amount which exceeds the six percent
3 (6%) withheld the following year from the Foundation and Salary
4 Incentive Aid for the school district.

5 B. Any school district with an average daily attendance (ADA)
6 of more than five hundred (500) students but not more than one
7 thousand five hundred (1,500) students for the preceding year which
8 expends for administrative services in the 2005-06 school year or
9 any school year thereafter, less expenditures for legal services,
10 more than eight percent (8%) of the amount it expends for total
11 expenditures, less expenditures for legal services, shall have the
12 amount which exceeds the eight percent (8%) withheld the following
13 year from the Foundation and Salary Incentive Aid for the school
14 district.

15 C. Any school district with an average daily attendance (ADA)
16 of five hundred (500) or fewer students for the preceding year which
17 expends for administrative services in the 2005-06 school year or
18 any school year thereafter, less expenditures for legal services,
19 more than ten percent (10%) of the amount it expends for total
20 expenditures, less expenditures for legal services, shall have the
21 amount which exceeds the ten percent (10%) withheld the following
22 year from the Foundation and Salary Incentive Aid for the school
23 district.

1 D. For purposes of this section, "administrative services"
2 means costs associated with:

- 3 1. Staff for the board of education;
- 4 2. The secretary/clerk for the board of education;
- 5 3. Staff relations;
- 6 4. Negotiations staff;
- 7 5. Staff for the superintendent, any elementary superintendent
8 or any assistant superintendent;
- 9 6. Any superintendent, elementary superintendent, or assistant
10 superintendent;
- 11 7. Any employee of a school district employed as a director,
12 coordinator, supervisor, or who has responsibility for
13 administrative functions of a school district; and
- 14 8. Any consultant hired by the school district.

15 E. If an employee of a school district is employed in a
16 position where part of the employee's time is spent as an
17 administrator and part of the time is spent in nonadministrative
18 functions, the percentage of time spent as an administrator shall be
19 included as administrative services. Except for a superintendent
20 who spends part of the time teaching in the classroom, the total
21 amount of time a superintendent of a school district spends
22 performing services for a school district shall be included as
23 administrative services even if part of the time the superintendent

1 is performing nonadministrative service functions and the total
2 amount received by a superintendent from the school district as
3 salary shall be recorded under the code for superintendent salary as
4 provided for in the Oklahoma Cost Accounting System.

5 F. Each school site within a school district shall take steps
6 to ensure that the administrative costs for the school comply with
7 the expenditure limits established for school districts in this
8 section.

9 G. Funds withheld pursuant to the provisions of this section
10 shall be distributed through the State Aid formula to the districts
11 not so penalized.

12 H. For the 2003-04 and 2004-05 school year, school districts
13 shall report to the State Department of Education the costs
14 associated with administrative services for the school district as
15 defined in subsection D of this section.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
