



1 all state departments, boards, councils, and commissions shall  
2 allocate, as a nondeductible item out of any expenditures for  
3 capital projects including, but not limited to, bond issues for  
4 state construction excluding costs for bond issuance and related  
5 reserves, an amount of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) of the  
6 expenditure to the Oklahoma Historical Society for the purpose of  
7 funding the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act, except as otherwise  
8 provided by subsection B of this section.

9       2. The maximum assessment for any project shall not exceed Five  
10 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). This assessment shall not  
11 apply to any private donations for a capital project. This  
12 allocation shall be applicable to all state agency capital projects  
13 approved by the appointing authority after September 1, 2004. The  
14 works of art commissioned pursuant to the Oklahoma Art in Public  
15 Places Act may be placed on public lands, integral to or attached to  
16 a public building or structure, or detached within or outside a  
17 public building or structure.

18       B. 1. Of the assessment provided for in subsection A of this  
19 section, four-fifths (4/5) shall be placed in the Commissioning of  
20 Art in Public Places Revolving Fund, created in Section 7 9030.6 of  
21 ~~Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1347 of the 2nd Session of the 49th~~  
22 ~~Oklahoma Legislature~~ this title, for the commission of any work of  
23 art for the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act. Institutions within  
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1 The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall remain in  
2 complete administrative control of their four-fifths (4/5)  
3 assessment pursuant to this subsection for the acquisition of art.  
4 The remaining one-fifth (1/5) of the assessment shall be reserved  
5 for the Art in Public Places Administrative and Maintenance  
6 Revolving Fund created by Section § 9030.7 of ~~Enrolled Senate Bill~~  
7 ~~No. 1347 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature~~ this  
8 title.

9 2. Monies deposited in the Art in Public Places Administrative  
10 and Maintenance Revolving Fund shall be divided equally between the  
11 subaccounts in the fund for:

- 12 a. the maintenance and repair of works of art  
13 commissioned pursuant to the Oklahoma Art in Public  
14 Places Act, and
- 15 b. the administrative and educational costs incurred by  
16 the Division.

17 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not be  
18 applicable for the fiscal year ending:

- 19 1. June 30, 2012;
- 20 2. June 30, 2013; and
- 21 3. June 30, 2014.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

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1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
