7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to labor; declaring certain contracts
9 void; providing exception; providing penalty;
10 providing for codification; and providing an
 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 701 of Title 40, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Except as provided by subsection B of this section, any
18 contract or agreement between a minor and a union is not a valid
19 contract or agreement and shall be null and void for any purpose
20 including, but not limited to, official recognition by a union for
21 purposes of intent or interest by a minor to join, vote, or consent
22 to any action of the union.

1 B. Any contract or agreement between a minor and a union shall
2 be signed and adjoined by the parent or legal guardian of the minor.
3 The minor, or parent or legal guardian of the minor, shall have the
4 right to rescind the contract or agreement within ninety (90) days
5 of the date of the contract or agreement.

6 C. Any funds received by a union in an attempt to contractually
7 obligate a minor, without meeting the provisions set forth in
8 subsection B of this section, shall be fully refunded to the minor
9 within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice from the
10 minor, or parent or legal guardian of the minor. If the full amount
11 of funds received by the union has not been refunded to the minor,
12 or parent or legal guardian of the minor within thirty (30) days,
13 the full amount of funds due shall double each successive thirty-
14 day-period until such refund is made in full to the minor, or parent
15 or legal guardian of the minor.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
