

1 domiciled in their jurisdictions for acquisitions pursuant to The
2 Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. The State Purchasing Director
3 shall annually prepare and distribute to certified procurement
4 officers a schedule providing which states give bidders in their
5 states a preference and the extent of the preference. This schedule
6 shall be used by state agencies in evaluating bids.

7 B. For purposes of awarding contracts state agencies shall:

8 1. Give a resident bidder a three percent (3%) preference to
9 goods and services that have been manufactured or produced in this
10 state if the price, fitness, availability and quality are otherwise
11 equal;

12 2. Give preference to goods and services from another state
13 over foreign goods or services if goods or services manufactured or
14 produced in this state are not equal in price, fitness,
15 availability, or quality; and

16 3. Add a percent increase to the bid of a nonresident bidder
17 equal to the percent, if any, of the preference given to the bidder
18 in the state in which the bidder resides.

19 C. For purposes of this section, "resident bidder" means an
20 individual, partnership, association, corporation, or other business
21 entity that, on the date the contract is first advertised or
22 announced as available for bidding:

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1 1. Has for one (1) year prior to and through the date of the
2 invitation to bid or request for proposal, filed Oklahoma corporate
3 income taxes, made payments to the Oklahoma unemployment insurance
4 fund, and maintained an Oklahoma workers' compensation policy in
5 effect; and

6 2. Has at least fifty-one percent (51%) of its property and
7 payroll located in Oklahoma.

8 D. The provisions of this section shall be made a part of the
9 invitation to bid or request for proposal.

10 E. The provisions of this section shall apply to all contracts
11 made by state agencies, political subdivisions, and school boards of
12 this state.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
