8                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9                   An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
10 allowing Oklahoma Turnpike Authority to incur certain  
11 utility line expenses; defining term; providing for  
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1736 of Title 69, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18                   For qualified education utility line projects requiring locating  
19 utility lines under a turnpike the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority may  
20 upon approval of the Authority by a majority vote incur all or a  
21 portion of the cost of locating the utility lines under the  
22 turnpike. As used in this section, "qualified education utility  
23 line project" means a project that is funded in whole or in part by

1 a general obligation bond issued by a school district after the vote  
2 approval required by Section 26 of Article X of the Oklahoma  
3 Constitution.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
