



1           1. The persons serving on the Board on June 30, 1988, shall  
2 continue to serve the full terms for which they were originally  
3 appointed until their successors have been duly appointed and  
4 approved with the advice and consent of the Senate. All future  
5 Boards shall continue the staggered terms of office established for  
6 the State Board of Registration for Foresters prior to July 1, 1988.

7           2. Any actions taken by any state agency on behalf of the State  
8 Board of Registration for Foresters or in an attempt to enforce the  
9 provisions of Sections 1201 through 1220 of this title shall be  
10 subject to review by the Board on and after the effective date of  
11 this act. Any such acts may be rescinded or modified as deemed  
12 appropriate by the Board, provided that such action shall not affect  
13 any accrued right, or penalty incurred, or proceeding begun between  
14 July 1, 1988, and the effective date of this act.

15           3. All funds collected after June 30, 1988, equipment, files,  
16 fixtures, furniture, and supplies of the Board which were  
17 transferred to the Department of Central Services or State Treasury  
18 pursuant to Section 3909 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall  
19 be returned to the care and custody of the Board on the effective  
20 date of this act.

21           4. All orders, determinations, rules, regulations, permits,  
22 certificates, licenses, contracts, rates, and privileges which have  
23 been issued, made, granted, or allowed by the Board and are in  
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1 effect on June 30, 1988, shall continue in effect according to their  
2 terms until further action is taken by the Board after the effective  
3 date of this act or as modified by law.

4 C. The Board shall consist of five (5) foresters who shall be  
5 selected and appointed by the Governor of Oklahoma, with the advice  
6 and consent of the Oklahoma State Senate, and who shall possess the  
7 qualifications set forth pursuant to the provisions of Section 1204  
8 of this title. Each qualified member of the Board shall receive a  
9 certificate of his appointment from the Governor and before  
10 beginning his term of office shall file with the Secretary of State  
11 his written oath or affirmation for the faithful discharge of his  
12 official duties.

13 D. The five members of the initial Board appointed after the  
14 creation of the Board on May 27, 1963, shall be appointed for terms  
15 of one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) years  
16 respectively. The initial Board and all future Boards shall always  
17 be composed of at least one member from each of the following  
18 fields: education, industry and public agency. On the expiration of  
19 the term of any member of the initial Board, the Governor shall, in  
20 the manner hereinbefore provided, appoint for a term of five (5)  
21 years a registered forester having the qualifications set forth in  
22 Section 1204 of this title to take the place of the member whose  
23 term on said Board is expiring. Each member shall hold office until

1 the expiration of the term for which such member is appointed and  
2 until a successor shall have been duly appointed and qualified.
