10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to state government; requiring
12 specified agencies to share information and
13 coordinate investigative and enforcement efforts for
14 certain purpose; authorization for creation of secure
15 database and promulgation of rules; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8152 of Title 74, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Workers' Compensation
22 Court, Department of Labor and Oklahoma Employment Security
23 Commission shall share information and coordinate investigative and
24 enforcement efforts for the purpose of detecting those employers who

1 intentionally misclassify individuals as independent contractors
2 rather than employees for the purpose of affecting procedures and
3 payments relating to withholding and social security, unemployment
4 tax or workers' compensation premiums. The agencies required by
5 this section to share information and coordinate efforts shall be
6 authorized to create a secure database of information accessible by
7 agency representatives responsible for enforcement and shall be
8 further authorized to enter into contracts and interagency
9 agreements and promulgate such rules as may be necessary to
10 implement this section.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
