



1       ~~Third.~~ 3. To cause such person to be sold as a slave, or in any  
2 way held to service against the will of such person,  
3 shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the  
4 custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding  
5 twenty (20) years. Upon any trial for a violation of this section,  
6 the consent thereto of the person kidnapped or confined, shall not  
7 be a defense, unless it appears satisfactorily to the jury, that  
8 such person was above the age of twelve (12) years, and that such  
9 consent was not extorted by threat, or by duress.

10       Except for persons sentenced to life or life without parole, on  
11 and after the effective date of this act, any person sentenced to  
12 imprisonment for a violation of this section and the offense  
13 involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, shall be required to  
14 serve a term of post-imprisonment supervision pursuant to  
15 subparagraph f of paragraph 1 of subsection A of Section 991a of  
16 Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes under conditions determined by the  
17 Department of Corrections. The jury shall be advised that the  
18 mandatory post-imprisonment supervision shall be in addition to the  
19 actual imprisonment.

20       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
