11 An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
12 designating the Trooper William McClendon Memorial
13 Highway; providing for codification; and declaring an
14 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the junction of U.S.
22 Highway 75 and West 201st Street South extending south to Okmulgee,
23 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Trooper William McClendon

1 Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause
3 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing
4 that name.

5 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
