7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments;
9 prohibiting convicted arsonist from working or
10 volunteering as a firefighter; defining terms;
 providing for codification; and providing an
 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1406 of Title 21, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of
18 Section 1401, 1402, 1403 or 1404 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
19 Statutes shall be prohibited from working or volunteering as a
20 firefighter in this state.

21 B. For the purposes of this section:

22 1. "Convicted" includes a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or
23 the imposition of deferred adjudication; and

1 2. "Firefighter" includes any person serving with or without
2 compensation as a firefighter as provided for in Titles 11, 18 and
3 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
