7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to children and juvenile code;
9 authorizing juvenile facilities to serve free meals
10 to staff and law enforcement personnel; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-613 of Title 10A, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 In order to protect the health and safety of the citizens of
18 this state, and to provide the state with the benefit of proper
19 security within the secure juvenile facilities of this state, all
20 staff or any other law enforcement personnel working within the
21 institution may, upon the approval of the superintendent of the
22 institution, be served the same meals served to the youth within
23 such institution. There shall be no cost to the personnel for such

1 meals. The agency may pay for these meals out of the funds
2 appropriated to the Office of Juvenile Affairs.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
