



1 resolution to the secretary of the county election board conducting  
2 such election. Such resolution shall contain the following facts:

3 1. The dates of the election or elections;

4 2. The offices to be filled or the questions to be voted upon  
5 at such election or elections;

6 3. Qualifications for such offices;

7 4. Designation of which offices shall be filled by voting by  
8 ward and which offices shall be filled by voting at large;

9 5. Indication of whether the election will be partisan or  
10 nonpartisan;

11 6. For charter cities where the charter is silent, indication  
12 of any portion of state law which will apply; ~~and~~

13 7. A list of precincts partially contained within the limits of  
14 the municipality which are eligible to be closed pursuant to the  
15 provisions of subsection C of Section 13-103 of this title, and a  
16 certification of whether such precincts shall be open or not open  
17 for the election; and

18 8. Any other information necessary for conducting said election  
19 or elections.

20 B. In the event that a municipality governed by charter  
21 schedules a regular or special election for a municipal office on  
22 the same date as an election involving state or federal offices, the  
23 filing period for such municipal office shall be scheduled on a  
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1 Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday not less than fifteen (15) days nor  
2 more than twenty (20) days following the date of the resolution or  
3 order.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
