4 the same purpose~~7~~. The assessment shall be based upon the assessed  
5 value of the property as determined by the current assessment roll  
6 of the county assessor in the county where the property is located,  
7 the assessed value as provided by the Oklahoma Tax Commission, or  
8 any other valuation which is rationally related to the benefit the  
9 property receives from the protection from flood and flood waters  
10 via the infrastructure contained within the district. The method of  
11 valuation utilized for the assessment of property pursuant to this  
12 section shall be at the sole discretion of the commissioners of the  
13 county in which the district is located. Properties Except for the  
14 state and any political subdivisions of the state, excluding school  
15 districts, properties that are exempt from ad valorem taxation are  
16 exempt from the assessment referred to within this section.

17 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1631 of Title 82, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The commissioners of any county in which a drainage district was  
21 organized and is continuing operations pursuant to statutes enacted  
22 prior to June 2, 2008, shall be authorized to reevaluate and  
23 subsequently modify the physical boundary of the district upon

1 making a fact-based finding that the newly proposed boundary is  
2 rationally related to those geographical areas which receive a  
3 direct benefit of protection from flood and flood waters via the  
4 infrastructure contained within the district, so long as those  
5 boundaries do not exceed the physical boundaries of the county in  
6 which the district is located.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
