9 An Act relating to public health and safety;
10 preventing individuals from receiving liver
11 transplant if tobacco products are used during
12 certain time; providing for codification; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2606 of Title 63, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 An individual shall be ineligible to receive a liver transplant
19 in the State of Oklahoma if tobacco products are used for a six-
20 month period prior to the scheduled transplant.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
