11 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; requiring
12 retail establishments offering certain cigarette
13 products to comply with certain provisions; providing
14 for codification; providing an effective date; and
15 declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 360.10 of Title 68, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Every person that maintains a machine or device at a retail
22 establishment that enables any person to process at that
23 establishment tobacco or any product that is made or derived from

1 tobacco into a roll or tube shall be deemed to be a manufacturer of
2 cigarettes and the resulting product shall be deemed to be
3 cigarettes sold to a consumer for purposes of the Master Settlement
4 Agreement Complementary Act, the provisions of Sections 301 through
5 325 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Unfair Cigarette and
6 Tobacco Products Sales Act, the provisions of Sections 346 through
7 352 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 600.21 through
8 600.23 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and the Fire Safety
9 Standard and Firefighter Protection Act.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
