3 B. Nine-one-one emergency telephone service information shall
4 be confidential. Any public law enforcement or public health agency
5 that uses nine-one-one emergency telephone service information for
6 the purposes set forth in subsection A of this section shall
7 establish methods and procedures that ensure the confidentiality of
8 the information.

9 C. Any governing body as defined in Section 2815 of this title
10 providing for the operation of emergency telephone service or nine-
11 one-one wireless emergency telephone service shall notify the
12 secretary of a county election board if a service user who is a
13 resident of the county has been assigned a new nine-one-one
14 emergency address or if the nine-one-one emergency address of a
15 service user who is a resident in that county has changed and shall
16 provide the new or updated address to the secretary for entry into
17 the voter registration database for the county. Notifications shall
18 be provided to any secretary of a county election board of any
19 county of which all or part of the county is located within the
20 nine-one-one service area. The notification shall be made to the
21 secretary within ninety (90) days of the assignment of the address
22 or the change in the address.

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1 D. For purposes of this section "nine-one-one emergency
2 telephone service information" shall mean the name, address and
3 telephone number of a service user of a local exchange telephone
4 company.

5 ~~D.~~ E. No governing body or person providing service pursuant to
6 this section shall be liable for using nine-one-one emergency
7 telephone service information, or providing such information to any
8 public law enforcement ~~or~~, public health agency or secretary of a
9 county election board, in accordance with subsection B or C of this
10 section.

11 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
