15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.199, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1210.199. A. This act shall be known and may be cited
19 as the "Dustin Rhodes and Lindsay Steed CPR Training Act".

20 B. ~~All~~ Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, all students
21 enrolled ~~in physical education in classes in grades nine through~~
22 ~~twelve~~ in the public schools of this state ~~may receive instruction~~
23 ~~in the techniques of~~ and in the private schools licensed by the

1 State Board of Education shall complete a course in cardiopulmonary
2 ~~resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver sufficient to enable the~~
3 ~~students to give emergency assistance to victims of cardiac arrest~~
4 ~~or choking~~ and the use of an automated external defibrillator, in
5 accordance with subsection C of this section, prior to graduating
6 from high school. All students enrolled in physical education in
7 classes in grades nine through twelve may receive instruction in the
8 techniques of the Heimlich maneuver.

9 C. ~~The State Department of Education may administer the~~
10 ~~cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver instruction~~
11 ~~program and train teaching personnel pursuant to rules adopted by~~
12 ~~the State Board of Education. Teaching materials and training~~
13 ~~courses provided by the American Red Cross, the American Heart~~
14 ~~Association and similar organizations may be utilized~~ The State
15 Board of Education shall adopt rules implementing a program of
16 instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an
17 automated external defibrillator. The program shall incorporate
18 psychomotor skills training and shall be based upon an instructional
19 program developed by the American Heart Association, the American
20 Red Cross, or an instructional program which is nationally
21 recognized and is based upon the most current national evidence-
22 based Emergency Cardiovascular Care guidelines for cardiopulmonary
23 resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator.

1 The State Department of Education shall provide training to school
2 personnel in the instructional programs implemented pursuant to this
3 subsection.

4 D. Each public school district board of education and each
5 governing board of a private school licensed by the State Board of
6 Education shall ensure that a minimum of one certified teacher and
7 one noncertified staff member at each school site receives training
8 in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and, the Heimlich maneuver and the
9 use of an automated external defibrillator each year.

10 E. School districts may use state funds allocated to the school
11 district for professional development to pay for or to reimburse
12 teachers and support personnel for training in the administration of
13 first aid and techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation and, the
14 Heimlich maneuver, and the use of an automated external
15 defibrillator.

16 F. Nothing in this section shall be construed to impose
17 liability on any school district or school district employee for
18 injury or death of any student, teacher, or other person resulting
19 from any cardiopulmonary or choking incident or to absolve any
20 school district or school employee of liability that might otherwise
21 exist under The Governmental Tort Claims Act.

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1 G. For purposes of this section, "psychomotor skills" means the
2 use of hands-on practice and the testing of skills to support
3 cognitive learning.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
