



1 1. Three members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives to be  
2 appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives;

3 2. Three members of the Oklahoma State Senate to be appointed  
4 by the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate;

5 3. The primary author of the Oklahoma House of Representatives  
6 and the primary author of the Oklahoma State Senate of this act  
7 creating the Legislative Task Force on The Oklahoma Central  
8 Purchasing Act;

9 4. A representative from the Governor's office to be appointed  
10 by the Governor;

11 5. A representative from the Attorney General's office to be  
12 appointed by Attorney General; and

13 6. A representative from the Department of Central Services to  
14 be appointed by Director of Department of Central Services.

15 C. Members of the Task Force shall serve at the pleasure of the  
16 appointing authority. Vacancies in a position shall be filled in  
17 the same manner as the original appointment.

18 D. The Task Force shall review and evaluate The Oklahoma  
19 Central Purchasing Act, including, but not limited to, bidding  
20 process and procedures, deadlines, and the appropriate or  
21 inappropriate involvement of the Legislature and agency directors.

1 E. The Task Force shall hold an organizational meeting not  
2 later than September 1, 2012. The Task Force shall select a chair  
3 and vice-chair at the first meeting.

4 F. Members of the Task Force shall receive no compensation or  
5 travel reimbursement for their service.

6 G. Staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by the  
7 staff of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma  
8 State Senate.

9 H. The Task Force may produce a final written report of its  
10 findings and recommendations. The report shall be submitted to the  
11 Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and  
12 the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate not later  
13 than December 31, 2012.

14 I. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force  
15 and effect of law and the Task Force shall terminate effective  
16 January 1, 2013.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
