

1 Statutes, a maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees in
2 excess of one hundred percent (100%) of the full-time-equivalent
3 employees budgeted under Section 34.42 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes by the agency, board, commission, department, program or
5 office of state government in the preceding fiscal year.

6 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
7 apply to the Office of the Governor, the Office of the Lieutenant
8 Governor, the Legislature, the Legislative Services Bureau, the
9 State Election Board, the Office of State Finance, or the Office of
10 the Secretary of State.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
