11 An Act relating to children; authorizing prosecution
12 of certain Department of Human Services employees for
13 certain violations; specifying requirements;
14 providing for punishment; prohibiting certain
benefits; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-8-110 of Title 10A, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Any child welfare worker, child welfare supervisor or other
22 employee of the Department of Human Services who knowingly and
23 intentionally falsifies any document in a deprived child proceeding

1 that results in the great bodily injury to or death of a child,
2 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine
3 of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment in the
4 custody of the Department of Corrections for up to two (2) years or
5 by both such fine and imprisonment.

6 B. Any employee of the Department of Human Services who is
7 convicted pursuant to this section shall forfeit any retirement or
8 other benefits accrued pursuant to Section 24.1 of Title 51 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
