8                   A Concurrent Resolution naming certain new building  
9                   the Bryan H. Potter Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy  
10                  Building; providing for placement of suitable  
11                  markers; and directing distribution.

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13                  WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter has been an Oklahoma licensed  
14                  pharmacist for 53 years; and

15                  WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter graduated from Southwestern Oklahoma  
16                  State University School of Pharmacy with a Bachelor of Science in  
17                  Pharmacy on May 23, 1957; and

18                  WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter has served on the Alumni Board of  
19                  Southwestern Oklahoma State University College of Pharmacy; and

20                  WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter was appointed by the Governor and  
21                  served as a Board member for the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy  
22                  for 17 years; and

1       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter served as Executive Director for the  
2 Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy for 19 years; and

3       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter served on the National Association of  
4 Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) Executive Committee for 10 years, and as  
5 President for one year; and

6       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter served on many national, state and  
7 local boards and organizations; and

8       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter received the Bowl of Hygeia Award and  
9 the Lester E. Hosto Distinguished Service Award; and

10       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter was inducted into the Oklahoma Pharmacy  
11 Hall of Fame in 1996; and

12       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter helped implement an electronic  
13 prescription monitoring program for Schedule II prescriptions; and

14       WHEREAS, Bryan H. Potter has served the citizens of the state  
15 and protected the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the  
16 state through the many facets of the practice of pharmacy; and

17       WHEREAS, the integrity and service of Bryan H. Potter will long  
18 be remembered; and

19       WHEREAS, this state has been greatly enriched by the public  
20 service of Bryan H. Potter; and

21       WHEREAS, a fitting memorial to this great man should be  
22 established by the naming of the Bryan H. Potter Oklahoma State  
23 Board of Pharmacy Building.

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
3 THEREIN:

4 THAT the new building being constructed at 2920 North Lincoln  
5 Boulevard, Oklahoma City, which shall be the permanent offices of  
6 the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy, shall be named the Bryan H.  
7 Potter Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Building.

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy provide for the  
9 placement of suitable markers designating the Bryan H. Potter  
10 Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy Building.

11 THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Bryan H. Potter  
12 and to the Executive Director of the Oklahoma State Board of  
13 Pharmacy.
