10 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
11 CONCURRING THEREIN:

12 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Senate
13 recognize all music therapy professionals, including members of
14 Oklahoma Music Therapists, who support, educate, and serve children
15 and adults with illness and disabilities.

16 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Senate
17 hereby proclaim the third week of February to the third week of
18 March in 2012 as "Music Therapy Month" at the State Capitol.
