



1 intravenously administered chemotherapy medications. The research  
2 shall include data provided to the Insurance Department by the seven  
3 largest health insurance providers in the state. Such data shall  
4 include the scope of cancer policies, the difference in policy  
5 coverage between oral anticancer medications and intravenously  
6 administered chemotherapy medications, and the number of individuals  
7 in the state who subscribe to such policies.

8 THAT the Task Force shall consist of the following eleven (11)  
9 members:

10 1. An individual representing the health care provider  
11 industry, appointed by the Governor;

12 2. An individual representing the health insurance industry,  
13 appointed by the Governor;

14 3. A licensed physician currently practicing oncology in this  
15 state, appointed by the Governor;

16 4. An individual representing the health care provider  
17 industry, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

18 5. An individual representing the health insurance industry,  
19 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

20 6. A licensed physician currently practicing oncology in this  
21 state, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

22 7. A member of the public, appointed by the Speaker of the  
23 House of Representatives;

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1 8. An individual representing the health care provider  
2 industry, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the State  
3 Senate;

4 9. An individual representing the health insurance industry,  
5 appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate;

6 10. A licensed physician currently practicing oncology in this  
7 state, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate;  
8 and

9 11. A member of the public, appointed by the President Pro  
10 Tempore of the State Senate.

11 THAT appointments to the Task Force shall be made by August 1,  
12 2012. The first meeting of the Task Force shall be called by House  
13 of Representatives staff and held by August 15, 2012. The members  
14 of the Task Force shall elect a chair at the first meeting of the  
15 Task Force. Additional meetings of the Task Force shall be held at  
16 the call of the chair of the Task Force. Members shall serve at the  
17 pleasure of their appointing authorities. A majority of the members  
18 of the Task Force shall constitute a quorum to transact business,  
19 but no vacancy shall impair the right of the remaining members to  
20 exercise all of the powers of the Task Force. A vacancy on the Task  
21 Force shall be filled by the original appointing authority. Staff  
22 support for the Task Force shall be provided by the staff of the  
23 House of Representatives and State Senate. The Insurance Department

1 shall provide support and information as requested by the Task  
2 Force.

3 THAT members of the Task Force shall receive no compensation or  
4 travel reimbursement for serving on the Task Force.

5 THAT the Task Force shall submit a report by November 15, 2012,  
6 to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the  
7 Speaker of the House of Representatives. The report shall include  
8 findings for any statutory or regulatory changes necessary to  
9 implement the recommendations of the Task Force.
