8                   A Concurrent Resolution commending the Fire Service  
9                   Instructors of Oklahoma and congratulating the

13                  WHEREAS, the Fire Service Instructors of Oklahoma is an  
14                  independent professional organization for fire service instructors  
15                  and persons interested in training with the fire service; and

16                  WHEREAS, the purpose of the Fire Service Instructors of Oklahoma  
17                  is to:

18                  1. Provide effective and continuous leadership, education and  
19                  training of the fire service for the protection of life and property  
20                  against fire and related man-made or natural disasters;

21                  2. Unite for professional benefit those members of the fire  
22                  service who share a sincere interest in fire service education as a  
23                  means of protecting life and property;

1 3. Provide an atmosphere for information and resource exchange  
2 between emergency responders, instructors and organizations involved  
3 in fire service education as a means of protecting life and  
4 property;

5 4. Promote cooperation among private enterprises, nonprofit  
6 organizations, associations and government agencies with an interest  
7 in fire service education at state and local levels;

8 5. Disseminate state-of-the-art materials concerning fire  
9 service education to the membership;

10 6. Encourage and support libraries of fire service training  
11 material and their establishment by others;

12 7. Encourage research and special studies and develop training  
13 and education programs and procedures, and analyze problems arising  
14 and their application; and

15 8. Promote the importance of the role of the fire service  
16 instructors in the total fire service organization; and

17 WHEREAS, this organization's motto is "quality instructors for  
18 quality instruction"; and

19 WHEREAS, the organization has provided quality leadership,  
20 training and education for over 30 years.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
22 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
23 CONCURRING THEREIN:

1        THAT the Oklahoma Legislature does hereby commend the Fire  
2 Service Instructors of Oklahoma for its contributions to the  
3 protection of life and property of Oklahomans through its  
4 leadership, education and training of the fire service.
