

1 Section 12. No member of Congress from this State, or person
2 holding any office of trust or profit under the laws of any other
3 State, or of the United States, shall hold any office of trust or
4 profit under the laws of this State. The provisions of this section
5 shall not apply to any person who is a member of the Oklahoma
6 National Guard or any reserve component of any branch of the United
7 States Military, who is ordered by the proper authority to active
8 service.

9 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
10 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
11 the following form:

14 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

15 This measure amends the State Constitution. It amends a section
16 that forbids persons holding state office from serving in a
17 federal office. This bars state officers from serving on active
18 duty in the National Guard or the Reserves. The proposed change
19 would let state officers serve on active duty if they are called
20 to do so.
