 citizens who have come to the Capitol in recognition
 of Rose Day.

16 WHEREAS, all members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
17 greatly esteem and respect this right of the citizens to give their
18 considered input and insight to elected members of the Oklahoma
19 House of Representatives, who are solemnly charged with crafting
20 legislation for the people as a whole; and

21 WHEREAS, the right to life of the unborn is one of the great
22 public-policy issues of our day, both for the American people and
23 for Oklahomans, of whatever political philosophy or persuasion; and

1 WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives affirm
2 that all human life is sacred from the point of conception; and

3 WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives oppose
4 President Barack Obama's stance on forcing physicians to perform
5 abortions against their consciences; and

6 WHEREAS, on Rose Day 2011, hundreds of our fellow Oklahomans
7 took time out of their busy lives to come to their State Capitol, to
8 make a public statement, respecting the sanctity of human life, and
9 the worth of every unborn individual, and to speak with their
10 elected officials; and

11 WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
12 greatly appreciate the heartfelt involvement of these committed
13 Oklahoma citizens, both young and old, male and female.
